Subject: Cancellation of the letter of award (LOA) memo No. 6244 dated: 20/12/2024 and order of blacklisting and debarred from further participation in the tender process for deliberate and knowingly violating the terms of the LOA.

Reference: LOA placed upon your company for Design, Survey, Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance of Solar Power Plants of cumulative capacity of 264 MWp (66 Projects of 4 MW Capacity each) near 66 evacuating substations and associated 11 KV transmission lines including integration of RMS data of the plants with the KUSUM portal for 25 years through RESCO mode for Feeder-level Solarisation of 75,000 Grid Connected Agricultural Pumps connected to 11KV Feeders emanating from 66 nos. of 66 KV PSPCL Substations in the state of Punjab, under Component-C of PM-KUSUM Scheme.

Reference-I: PEDA email dated: 07/01/2025 requesting compliance of the terms of clause No. 4 of the LOA dated: 20/12/2024.

Reference-II: Response Email dated: 07/01/2025 by your company M/s VP Solar Generations Private Limited for extension of time comply with the terms.

Reference -III: PEDA email dated: 08/01/2025 again requesting comply with the terms, aforementioned.

Reference to the LOA no. 6244 dated 20.12.2024 placed upon your company for reference-I cited above. As per the LOA and DNIT, specifically regarding the compliance of clause No. 4 requiring your company to submit the **performance bank guarantee of Rs.13,20,00,000/-** (Thirteen Crores Twenty Lakhs) @ Rs. 5 lakhs per MW capacity basis within period of 14 days from the date of issue of LOA i.e. upto

03.01.2025. However, your company had failed to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee with PEDDA within the stipulated time.

As a matter of abundant caution, PEDDA had sent the emails dt. 07.01.2025 informing the default for not having submitted the PBG by dated: 03/01/2025.

Your company, on dated: 07/01/2025 replied to the above email and had informed that it required more time to comply with the term of the PBG.

In response to the above stated email, PEDDA had again sent an email on dated: 08.01.2025 that under the settled terms as well as the LOA, there was no stipulation or any term under which further time could be granted to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee, but till date your company has not submitted the required Performance Bank Guarantee which is deliberate default, despite adequate & full knowledge.

It is further informed that under clause 5 of the above LOA, the Power Purchase Agreement with Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd (PSPCL) was required to be signed within 21 days after the issuance of the LOA, which time period has also expired on dated: 10/01/2025, which date has also long gone passed by.

It is now been more than 3 weeks from the last date since which your company was required to submit the PBG and about 2 weeks from the requirement of the signing of the Power Purchase Agreement.

In view of non-submission of PBG as well as the non-signing of the PPA by your company, the Letter of Award no. 6244 dated 20.12.2024 is proposed to be cancelled and the entire process of tendering and the selection of the eligible entity would have to be repeated, which is done at a huge cost and time incurred by PEDDA.

In view of the above proposal, your company was issued the show cause notice vide memo No. 389 dated: 24/01/2025 through email and also through a registered/speed post to show cause as to why the proposed action of the cancellation of the letter of award No. 6244 dated: 20/12/2024 may not be carried out and as to why your company should not be debarred and denied further participation in the tender process and also as to why your company should not be blacklisted for a period of 5 years from the date of the passing of the order.

The above notice has been duly received by your company and the response, if any, was required to be submitted by 30/01/2025, however, no response has been received and it is presumed that your company has nothing to say regarding the show cause notice memo No. 389 dated: 24/01/2025, specially, in view of the fact that despite adequate and proper knowledge for the non-submission of the PBG within the time provided i.e. till dated: 03/01/2025, the same has not been submitted as per the terms of clause No. 4. As per the requirements of the clause No. 5, the PPA has also not been signed with the PSPCL.

Keeping in view the above stated facts and the non-compliance of the requirements of clause No. 4 of the LOA memo No. 6244 dated: 20/12/2024, it is ordered that your company, M/s. VP Solar Generations Private Limited, including its Directors, Sh. Parmod Chaudhary, Sh. Harpal Singh and Mrs. Anu Chaudhary are




debarred from taking part in the tender process. The Directors have been barred so that they do not participate in the tendering process by floating a new entity, since, the Directors had full knowledge regarding the requirements of the LOA. It is because of their conduct, the huge cost involved in the tendering process and the time has gone to utter waste in the entire process may have to be repeated. The grant of the LOA for the project was required to be carried out in a time bound manner of the feeder level solarization of the grid connected agricultural pumps under the MNRE Scheme. The non-compliance would lead to serious setback in carrying out the entire process. Further, your company, VP Solar Generations Private Limited is also blacklisted. This order shall remain in operation for the next 5 years from the date of its issuance.

Kindly also keep under advisement that PEDDA shall also be entitled to receive all such amounts that have been spent for above purposes, which shall not be limited to the tender process, the signing of the LOA and various other steps having been taken regarding above LOA.
